The SHARING GOOD PRACTICES IN THE FIELD OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ACROSS EUROPE project is now officially launched!

This exchange project is a European project, funded by the Erasmus+ Programme (Strategic partnerships for vocational education and training) for the 2019- 2022 period. The project will be implemented in Hungary, Greece, Turkey, Italy, Portugal, and Malta.

The Exchange project aims at promoting good practice sharing amongst the countries and institutions that participate, in the field of vocational education. Our project is to increase expertise specifically of members of the directorate, economists, professionals in the field of finance, vocational training students and professionals in the field of vocational education through good practices from different perspectives and with different goals.

Each of the partners brings their own specialization and novel knowledge and expertise to this project. Ranging from practical aspects to management and networking, our team of partners has planned to incorporate every aspect that may be of interest to professionals that take an interest in the vocational education field from all different perspectives.

The project is expected to have a high impact both in short and long term. In the short term, the transnational nature of the exchange will ensure not only a multitude of ideas to be compared and understood, but also different needs and perspectives to be considered regarding implementation of the practices. In the long term, the project is expected to positively influence EU Member States towards adopting more specialized and state-of-the-art practices in their field of vocational education on a local and even national level.

Project activities

The basic activities of the SHARING GOOD PRACTICES IN THE FIELD OF VOCATIONAL EDUCATION ACROSS EUROPE project are as follows:

1. Production of professional Handbook including all the best practices shared:

This part of the project aims to both bring together and present all the good practices that will be brought forward by associate partners, gather them into a handbook that will be easy to distribute, access and familiarize with, in order to



allow the transmission of knowledge both into the present as well as into the future, adjusted and translated to the language of each of the partners.

2. Transnational training events, with real life examples:

This part of the project will take place in each of the countries of the partner organizations, who will in turn present their good practice, not only to the other partners but also professionals that are interested in a first-hand experience of the know-how of each specific practice. These will take place during the transnational meetings and will be accompanied by other events such as managerial tasks and meetings regarding the progression of the project in all aspects.

3. Online courses as follow-ups to the best practice showcase for each partner:

This part of the project will ensure that the knowledge acquired during the training sessions at every transnational meeting is fully realized by the professionals that have been trained and exposed to it. Through a series of online courses and evaluation reports, on a tight time-frame, not long after the training events, will make sure that the practices have both been understood as well as deeply learned and possessed by the trainees, ready to be transferred back to their professional environments and spread across their circles.

Kick-off meeting

We are happy to inform you that the kick-off meeting of the project was a success!

The first meeting, which took place in Debrecen, Hungary during February, the partners had the chance to meet up, get to know each other and share their views and goals, as well as plans for the upcoming project.

During the meeting, each partner presented their organization, expertise, and background, followed by a presentation of the good practice that each will bring to the table during the project. In addition, plans for the website, the handbook and the online courses were consolidated and agreed upon, routes of communication were decided, and the partner agreement was signed.

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food and to meet great people, in order to create long-lasting bonds that will make the project even more successful and interesting for everyone!
